The Fundamentals Module

includes the Basic Training Course. This course is designed to lay the foundation for counseling people biblically. It will help you reach out to those hurting around you, influence others for the glory of God, and be more effective in your personal ministry. This course is required to obtain ACBC Certification.

The Advanced Modules

Rethinking the Issue of Abuse

February 16, 9:00am-12:00pm
